Yard Sale or Garage Sale Registration Required

Yard Sale or Garage Sale (Section 5-1401/5-1410)

Definition: The following words, terms, and phrases, when used in this Chapter, shall have the meaning ascribed to them in this section, except when the context clearly indicates a different meaning. The word “shall” is always mandatory and not merely directory.

A person shall not conduct an occasional sale (Yard Sale or Garage Sale) for duration of more than four (4) consecutive calendar days. A person shall not conduct more than four (4) sales at a premise during a calendar year. A person shall not place more than two (2) signs, not exceed four square feet, at remote locations. Signs must be placed on private property (signs are prohibited in the public right-of-way, on telephone poles, utility poles, traffic or road signs, etc. These are illegal and will be removed by City Employees) and must have permission of property owner. Signs must be removed within 24 hours following the sale. Signs placed other than on private property and signs placed without the property owner’s permission may be removed.

If inclement weather prevents the occasional sale, the Director of Code Compliance may, in his/her sole discretion, issue a replacement permit. The applicant must request the replacement permit within one week after the date of the cancelled occasional sale. No more than one replacement permit shall be issued per calendar year per address.
