2. Fill cracks, pop outs and peeling area before application of surfacing material.
3. Apply one coat of resurfacer to all repaired areas.
4. Apply two coats of acrylic surfacing material.
5. Material to be **World Class Athletic Surfacing, Plexipave 100% acrylic materials or equal.**
6. Colors shall be a blue court with red exterior and white lines. Owner reserves the right to change colors at same costs.

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Stipulations

In submitting the bid, the undersigned agrees:

1. Bid will not be withdrawn within the period of 45 calendar days following the opening thereof.

2. If notified of the acceptance of the bid, contractor shall execute a contract for the work and deliver to the Owner within 10 calendar days after such notification.
3. The Work included under the contract shall be completed within 90 calendar days. Liquidated damages in the amount of \$75 per calendar day shall be imposed on the contractor for every day past the deadline of 90 calendar days until the project is substantially complete and accepted by the Owner.
4. The right is reserved by the Owner to reject any or all bids and to waive any informalities in bids received.
5. The Owner shall have the right to consider alternate surfacing materials and determine the low Bidder on the basis of the sum of the Base Bid and Alternate accepted.
6. No contract is given or implied regarding the project until funding is appropriated and the Owner has offered a written contract to the contractor and both parties have fully executed the contract. No offer has been made to the contractor until the aforementioned items have transpired.
7. The Bidder agrees to furnish all necessary materials, equipment, machinery, tools, apparatus, means of transportation and labor necessary to complete the construction of the work as described as reasonable intended requirements of the contract documents. Any change in scope will be per Owner and Contractor agreement but shall be based on unforeseen circumstances.

8. The successful Bidder will be paid with a lump sum within (7) seven days of the conclusion and acceptance of the Project by the Owner.
  
9. The successful Bidder will supply proof of appropriate State license, insurance coverage, and affidavit of Drug Free Workplace (if over five employees).
