12-202. Trees projecting over streets, etc., regulated. It shall be unlawful for any property owner or occupant to allow any limbs or trees on his property to project out over any street, alley or sidewalk at a height of less than fourteen (14) feet.

12-203. Trees, etc., obstructing views at intersections prohibited. It shall be unlawful for any property owner or occupant to have or maintain on his property any tree, hedge, billboard, or other obstruction, which prevents persons driving vehicles on public streets or alleys from obtaining a clear view of traffic when approaching an intersection.

12-207. Littering streets, alleys or sidewalks prohibited. It shall be unlawful for any person to litter, place, throw, or allow to fall on any street, alley or sidewalk any refuse, glass, tacks, leaves, lawn clippings, or other objects or materials which are unsightly or which obstruct or tend to limit or interfere with the use of such public ways and places for their intended purposes.

12-208. Obstruction of drainage ditches. It shall be unlawful for any person to permit or cause the obstruction of any drainage ditch in any public right-of-way.

12-210. Parades regulated. It shall be unlawful for any club, organization or similar group to hold any meeting, parade, demonstration or exhibition on the public streets of the municipality without some responsible representative first securing a permit from the chief of police. No permit shall be issued by the chief of police unless such activity will not reasonably interfere with traffic flow and unless such representative shall agree to see to the immediate cleaning up of all litter which shall be left on the streets as a result of the activity. Furthermore, it shall be unlawful for any

person obtaining such a permit to fail to carry out his agreement to immediately clean up the resulting litter.

12-211. Operation of trains at crossing regulated. No person shall operate any railroad train across any street or alley without giving a warning of its approach as required by state law; nor shall be made such crossing at a speed in excess of seven (7) miles per hour. It shall also be unlawful for any person operating a railroad train to block or obstruct any street or alley for a period of more than five (5) consecutive minutes.

12-212. Animals and vehicles on sidewalks. It shall be unlawful for any person to ride, lead or tie any animal, or ride, push, pull or place any vehicle across or upon any sidewalk in such a manner as to unreasonably interfere with or inconvenience pedestrians using the sidewalk. It shall also be unlawful for any person to knowingly allow any minor under his control to violate this section.

12-215. Maintain watchman at certain crossings. The Louisville and Nashville Railroad Company is hereby required to establish and maintain, at its own expense a watchman from 6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., where Dunlap Street and Poplar Street cross said railway and from 6:00 a.m. until 10:00 p.m., where Rison Street and Depot Street across said railway; subject nevertheless, to the substitution of an electrical device in lieu thereof as hereafter provided.
