PARENTS' CODE OF CONDUCT

As a Parent, I (and my guests) hereby state that we will:

- Make every effort for my child to attend all practices and games. If not then we will give proper notification to the Head or asst coach.
- Be a positive role model for my child and encourage sportsmanship by showing respect and courtesy, and by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, officials and spectators at every game and practice.
- Be on my/our best behavior and will NOT engage in any kind of unsportsmanlike conduct with any official, coach, player or parent on my child's team and the opposing team such as booing and taunting, allowing my child to refuse to shake hands, or using profane language or gestures.
- Insist that the children play in a safe and healthy environment.
- Remember that this game is for children and not for adults.
- Will not encourage any behaviors or practices that would endanger the health and well-being of athletes.
- Demand that my child treat other players, coaches, officials and spectators with respect at all times regardless of race, creed, color, sex or ability.
- Never ridicule or yell at any children for making a mistake.
- Respect the officials and coaches for their authority during games and practices; I
 will never question, discuss, or confront coaches at the gym, but will take time to
 speak with coaches and agreed-upon time and place.
- Refrain from coaching my child or other players during games and practices, unless I am a registered coach or asst coach for the team.
- Not approach the scorer's table, coach or officials at any time.
- Not use drugs, tobacco and alcohol during practice or game.
- Understand that the Coach is a volunteer and know that he/she is not getting paid.
- Understand that an official or designated member of the PHCBL has the authority to remove me or any spectator for violating any part of this Code of Conduct.
- Not do anything to intimidate, offend, insult, humiliate or discriminate against any other person on the ground of gender, race, disability, age, religious or political belief, sexual orientation, social background, ethnic origin, language, marital or civil partnership status, or pregnancy.

I understand and agree to the Parents Code of Conduct. I also understand that by not following this Code, it could result in Disciplinary actions, including, but not limited to suspension from all gymnasiums.
